God's Great Purpose

God's purpose for the earth is to fill it with His glory. When Jesus Christ returns, there will be a resurrection and judgment, and faithful people will be rewarded with eternal life. God's Kingdom on the earth will be a beautiful place of peace, fruitfulness, justice, health and happiness.

"But truly, as I live, all the earth shall be filled with the glory of the Lord"

Numbers 14:21

God's great purpose with the earth is to fill the earth with His glory. He wants the earth to be full of people who are like Him, who love Him and who do His will (Matthew 6:9-10). This will happen when Jesus returns to the earth to set up God's Kingdom.

Jesus Christ's Return to Earth

"When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, then he will sit on his glorious throne. Before him will be gathered all the nations."

Matthew 25:31

When Jesus went up to heaven after he rose from the dead, his disciples were watching, wondering what was happening. Two messengers from God said to them "Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into heaven? This Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will come in the same way as you saw him go into heaven." (Acts 1:11).

When Jesus returns to earth, there will be a resurrection of some of the dead (Daniel 12:2, 1 Thessalonians 4:16). Those with a knowledge of God's ways will be judged, separating good people and bad people (Romans 2:6-9, 12). Those found to be faithful will be given eternal life – their bodies will be changed and they will be made immortal (1 Corinthians 15:51-53) but those judged unfaithful will die (Romans 6:23).

The Kingdom

- Jesus Christ will be the King (Luke 1:32-33)
- The Kingdom will be based in Jerusalem in Israel, but will fill the whole earth. Everyone will learn God's ways (Isaiah 2:2-3, Habakkuk 2:14)
- All the kings and rulers on the earth will submit to Jesus Christ as the king (Psalm 72:8-11)
- Immortal people (those who have been found faithful) will rule with Jesus Christ (Revelation 5:9-10)
- The earth will become beautiful again (Isaiah 35:1-2)
- There will be peace on the earth (Isaiah 2:4)
- Everyone will be safe (Micah 4:4)
- Even animals will be at peace with each other (Isaiah 11:6-9)
- There will be plenty of food (Psalm 72:16; Zechariah 8:12)
- Poor people will be looked after (Psalm 72:12-14)
- There will be true justice (Psalm 72:2, Isaiah 11:3-4)
- There will be good health (Isaiah 35:5-6)

- People will live for a long time (Isaiah 65:20)
- There will be joy and happiness (Isaiah 25:8, Revelation 21:4)
- The Kingdom will last 1,000 years (Revelation 20:4)
- At the end of the 1,000 years there will be another resurrection and judgment of the people who have died during the Kingdom (Revelation 20:5,12-15)
- After the second resurrection there will be no more death (Isaiah 25:8, Revelation 21:4, 1 Corinthians 15:25-26)
- Jesus Christ will give the Kingdom back to God his Father, and God 'will be all and in all' (1 Corinthians 15:24-28)

What a wonderful time the Kingdom of God will be! We can prepare for the coming of Jesus Christ by reading the Word of God (Romans 10:17), believing the Gospel and being baptised (Mark 16:16), then living a life of service to God (Ephesians 4:1-2).
